Announcement 3/24/2020

- When: <u>Effective 3/1/2020</u>
- How long? <u>Expires April 16, 2020</u>
 - (but will be reevaluated for continuance)
- "Member cost-sharing (copayment, deductible, co-insurance) will be waived for all identified telehealth services, <u>regardless of whether there</u> <u>is a diagnosis related to COVID-19.</u>

ALAPTA Recommendations:

- Document the telehealth visit just as you would an in-person visit. Insure you support the type of service provided, as well as the length of time spent providing each service(s).
- Keep good records so you will know what to bill once the guidelines are released. Keep track of the services using CPT™ codes, and the amount of time spent for each CPT™ as well as the total time spent.
